Thank you for participating in the USDA Summer Meals Program. This program provides free meals that meet federal nutrition guidelines, while school is out. There are no income requirements, and any child aged 18 and younger is welcome to eat.

We wanted to make you aware that our summer feeding program will end on **(6/26/2026)**. Summer Meals sites are located across Arizona and may continue operating throughout the summer. They offer a combination of breakfasts, lunches, snacks, and suppers. In some rural areas, these meals may be delivered or picked up. To find a participating site near you, please visit

We also wanted to make sure you were aware of SUN Bucks (Summer-EBT), which provides grocery-buying benefits to low-income families with school-aged children who lose access to free or reduced-price school meals when schools are closed for the summer. The deadline to apply is August 3, 2026.
